**Where?** Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana

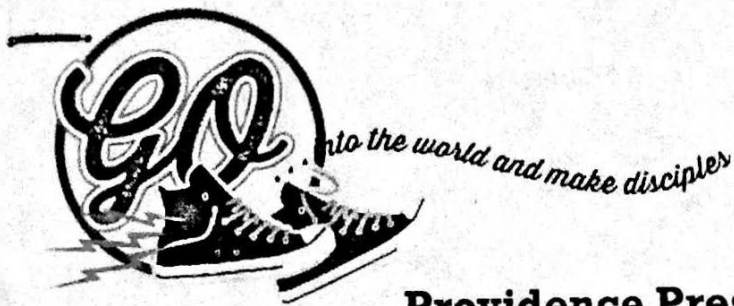
